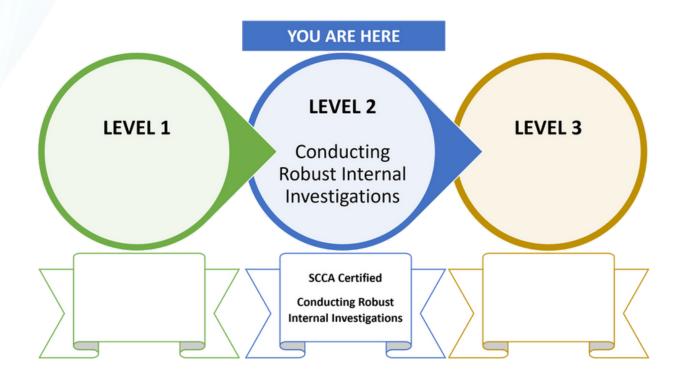

Jesu also chaired AGC's Innovation Network, which was tasked with creating a culture of innovation.

Notably, Jesu is a recognised specialist in the area of export controls and UN sanctions, with a special focus on Iran and the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. He worked closely with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Trade & Industry, Singapore Customs, and the Maritime Port Authority of Singapore as well as foreign counterparts, when he advised on Singapore's international obligations.

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United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs (UNODA)

Jesu is an internationally sought after thought leader in the field of compliance, and financial crimes and has presented at numerous conferences and seminars on these subjects. Recently, he was recognized as an Expert by the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs (UNODA), Expertise France, and serves as Singapore's representative (nominated by the Singapore's Ministry of Foreign Affairs) to the EUP2P's working group in connection to a global publication on dual-use goods trade controls.
